

Eruv Declaration (Betzah 2:1 9b)

ר' חייא בשם ר' יוחנן צריך לומר עלי ועל מי שלא עירב (ביצה ב:א ט:)

Read plainly Rabbi Hiyya is saying that whenever one makes an Eruv Tavshilin for himself he should bear in mind anyone else who did not end up making one. The blessing that one recited prior to making the Eruv Tavshilin should include the declaration of [עירוב זה] עלי ועל מי "שלא עירב", "[This Eruv] is for me and for anyone who did not make an Eruv Tavshilin". (Rashba, Avodath Haqodhesh, Eruve Tavshilin, #2)

The formula is not mentioned in the Talmud Bavli.
